Eligible students who are pursuing a degree in natural or marine sciences are encouraged to apply. Fields of study may include, but are not limited to Botany, Horticulture, Landscape Architecture, Marine Biology, Coastal Wetlands Preservation, Ecology, Pollinator Research and Photography.

Historically three or four scholarships have been awarded in the range of \$5,000-\$10,000. By awarding these scholarships, we hope to enhance the college experience for a well- qualified, hard-working student and to inspire him or her to pursue their dreams in their specialized field of study.

To be eligible for the Scholarship the student shall:

- 1. Be a citizen of the United States and a bona fide resident of the state of Florida for at least two years preceding the academic year for which application is made.
- 2. Have declared a major in the study of horticulture, botany, landscape design, environmental science, marine science or any other natural science subject.
- 3. Have finished at least 12 credit hours at an accredited Florida institution.
- 4. Submit two letters of recommendation from staff members in the field of study.
- 5. Submit a resume of extracurricular activities, honors, leadership, job experience, non- school activities and community service.
- 6. Submit a statement explaining your interest in earning a degree in a natural science field and your future plans.
- 7. Have maintained a 3.0 GPA or above grade average.
- 8. Provide transcripts.
- 9. Be available for a personal interview if requested.

Scholarship recipients may reapply if they continue to meet the criteria for the award.
