Here is a sample of scholarships awarded to students in prior years:

Scholarship Student #1 – University of Florida

Our first recipient is a Marine Sciences major with a concentration on coastal invertebrates, coastal animal and plant species as well as their ecosystems. Her ultimate goal is to become a field research scientist in order to spread awareness for coastal marine habitat conservation. She also seeks to test effective ways to rebuild coastal habitats that have been lost to development, erosion, and sea-level rise.

Our second recipient is a Biology major with a concentration in micro-biology. His primary interest is to research methods to preserve Florida ecosystems and help them thrive.
