This scholarship is made available to students at the Junior and Senior level or, in some cases higher, who are majoring in the study of horticulture, floriculture, botany, landscape design, conservation, environment, forestry, agronomy, plant pathology, or allied subjects.

In the past the Longboat Key Garden Club has awarded scholarships ranging from \$1,500 – 7,000 to deserving students attending accredited colleges/universities throughout the State. Please feel free to copy and share this information with any other faculty members you believe have eligible students who could benefit from this scholarship.

The opportunity for eligible students to apply for a Longboat Key Garden Club Scholarship ends on March 15, 2017. The scholarship award will be announced on or about April 1, with the presentation made at the Club's Annual Meeting on April 18, at 11:30 AM in Longboat Key's Joan Durante Park.

Guidelines for
Longboat Key Garden Club Scholarship

The purpose of this award is to recognize academic achievement and to lend assistance to college Juniors, Seniors, or above, who are majoring in a subject pertaining to Longboat Key Garden Club objectives.

AWARD:

Award amounts generally range from \$2,000 - \$4,000. However, depending on the number and quality of applications, awards can range from \$1,000 - \$6,000. Scholarship awards are presented at the Annual Meeting & Picnic Luncheon (third Tuesday of April at 11:30 AM) at the Joan M. Durante Park, 5550 Gulf of Mexico Drive, Longboat Key, FL 34228.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for the Longboat Key Garden Club Scholarship, the student shall:

1. Be a citizen of the United States, who has been a bona fide resident of Florida for at least two years preceding the academic year for which application is made.
2. Be enrolled, or accepted, as a full-time student, or no less than half-time, in any senior accredited college or university in Florida.
3. Be majoring in the study of horticulture, floriculture, botany, landscape design, conservation, environment, forestry, agronomy, plant pathology, or allied subject.
4. Have completed two years of study and have maintained a 3.0 or above grade average, or its equivalent, with enough credits for enrollment as a Junior, or above, at an accredited Florida college or university.
5. Attach four (4) letters of recommendation: two (2) from staff members of the applicant's present college; and two (2) from unrelated citizens of good standing in the community.
6. Attach a one-page resume of extra-curricular activities, honors, leadership, job experience, and non-school activities.
7. Attach a one-page essay, stating the applicant's field of study, objective of higher education, future plans, and why financial assistance is requested.
8. Apply for this scholarship by March 15. Selection will be made in early April.
9. Grant permission to the college of the applicant to release transcripts to donor.
10. Be available for a personal interview if requested.
